

In Thakurgaon, the sale of talshans has increased due to the intensity of heat

Talshans are sold in the market at this time every year in Thakurgaon. This delicious seasonal fruit is in great demand. However, since there is not much demand for palm in different districts of the country, traders bring them to neighboring districts including Thakurgaon in the hope of selling the shells while the palm is still small. As the demand for coconut oil is high, every trader gets financial gain by selling it. This year too, Talshans are being sold in several places including Amtali, Bus Stand, Thakurgaon Road, Kalibari Bazaar. On sale from morning till midnight every day. Talshans trader Azahar said, some of us have come from Adamdighi in Bogra district. We buy palm plantations every year in Bogra. The garden has about 130-150 palm trees. We buy garden under contract for 1 to 1.5 lakh taka and sell it according to the demand in different districts of the country. Another seller Nazmul Hasan said, I have been in Thakurgaon for a few days. Selling 25 taka per piece. Also each palm is being sold at 10 taka. Each beat has at least 3 breaths. Also if one buys a large quantity of taal or talshans, a little less money is charged. Abdul Karim, a businessman of Kalibari market in the city, said that it has been several days that palm oil is being sold. Selling enough. The number of buyers is also high. By selling taal every day, excluding all expenses, the profit is like 1 thousand to 1.5 thousand taka. Md. Rashedul Islam of Shahpara Mohalla, a buyer who came to buy palm fiber, said that it is available at this time every year. It is very tasty and good to eat. 2-4 Ashes are available from each piece of palm. I bought a big one for 30 taka per piece. If the price was a little lower, more quantity could be taken. Md. Abdul

Ali, a resident of Barunagaon village of Salandar Union of Sadar Upazila, said, Talshans is very favorite of me and my family. Each tala of flour was sold at Rs 5 to 10 last year; But this year it is selling at 20-30 rupees. Dr. Minhaj Kaushik, Medical Officer of Thakurgaon 250 bedded General Hospital spoke about the benefits of rhythm breathing. He said, it is a very popular fruit. Palm oil contains some nutrients that are very beneficial for the body. It helps to eliminate dehydration, increases immunity, sharpens eyesight, plays a special role in bone formation. Talswans also contain vitamin A, C and B complex which helps in sharpening eyesight. It contains antioxidants that boost immunity. Helps relieve nausea. It helps in curing liver problems. After all, consuming palm oil regularly is very beneficial to make the skin beautiful, bright and glowing.
