

# **Mymensingh A. League leaders illegally sold crores of government sand**

**Ayub Ali, Mymensingh**– League leaders are looting government sand for river mining in Mymensingh. Mymensingh Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue) Shihab Uddin Ahmed said that there is no opportunity to sell sand without tender.

Mymensingh was informed about the search. Your owner requests you to supply various types of supplies including sand RPCL without tender. Using AL Power Emdad Mandal and Mymensingh Thana AL Secretary. Ward No. 32 City Councilor Abu Bakar Siddique Sagar, Ward No. 31 former Councilor Jamal Hossain, Jubo League Chaura Salim, BNP worker Wasim Akram and Char Ishwardia Union BNP General Secretary Tofazzal Hossain. After the fall of the government on August 5, the leaders and councilors of the A.L. Fled away. However, BNP worker Wasim and BNP leader Tofazzal are currently running the illegal sand business of A.L. leaders and councilors. Every day hundreds of truckloads of sand are sold illegally and embezzled by themselves without depositing the government money in the treasury.



Findings revealed that at least hundreds of trucks of sand are being sold every day. The price of one truck of sand ranges from Eighteen hundred taka to 20 thousand taka. The sale of sand for one day is about 20 lakh TK. In this regard, BNP leader Tofazzal Hossain said that the allegations against me are not true. I am not involved in selling sand. Emdad Mandal owns Mandal Enterprise 60% percent, Jamal Hossain 35% percent and the remaining 5% percent is owned by Akram Enterprise, himself (Wasim Akram). Wasim Akram said that he and others have been selling sand since 2021 under the influence of A.L. without any lease. A.League leader in sand business, besides, he has been running the business by using his truck for sand transportation. Waseem Akram said, "I have lost many cases while making a party, and asked if he can't do business." In this regard, Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue) of Mymensingh Shihab Uddin Ahmed said that there is no opportunity to sell Govt sand without tender. Tender process

is ongoing. If they sell sand before this, it will be illegal. However, if I receive a written complaint, action will be taken against them. It is noted that Mymensingh is excavating the old Brahmaputra river and excavating sand with dredgers to restore its navigability. That sand is piled up on both banks of the river. From there, the sand traders are embezzling illegally by selling sand worth crores of TK''s without depositing it in the government treasury.
