It is important to note that the 29th session of the Conference of the Parties to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP29) will be held in Azerbaijan in just a few days. This decision was made during the COP28 plenary session in Dubai on December 11 of last year.

The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) is an international treaty signed in June 1992 at the Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro, aimed at preventing dangerous human interference with the climate system. The acronym "COP" stands for the "Conference of the Parties," which is the highest decision-making body responsible for overseeing the implementation of the Convention.

The Convention has 198 parties, and COP meetings are typically held annually unless the parties decide otherwise. The first COP took place in Berlin in March 1995, and the UNFCCC Secretariat is based in Bonn, Germany.
