

No security threat over Victory Day: Home Adviser

BSS – Home Affairs Adviser Lieutenant General (retd) Md Jahangir Alam Chowdhury today said there is no possible security threat to the law and order situation during the celebrations of the upcoming Victory Day.

“By the grace of Allah, there is no security threat to the law and order situation of the country on the Victory Day, as the day is not for any particular group or individual, but rather the day belongs to all people of the country,” he said.

The adviser made these remarks while talking to journalists after coming out of a meeting at the conference room of the ministry this afternoon over the overall security measures and the law-order situation ahead of Victory Day.
