

What's in 'Emilia Perez'?

Adriana Paz, Carla Sofia Gascone, Selena Gomez and Zoe Saldana – these four won the Best Actress award at the Cannes Film Festival last year. They won the award for Jacques Andier's 'Emilia Perez'. The film was praised after its premiere at Cannes, but who would have thought that this musical comedy would be so well received later! After receiving the highest nominations at the two major award ceremonies, it seems that the discussion about 'Emilia Perez' will increase even more.

The 82nd Golden Globe Awards will be given tomorrow morning Bangladesh time. The film surprised everyone by receiving the maximum 10 nominations at this year's ceremony. It has received nominations in all important categories including Best Picture in the Musical or Comedy category, Best Actress, and Best Supporting Actress. Critics believe that the film can also take home the highest award like the nomination.

Meanwhile, the BAFTA nominations were announced last Friday night. The film has received the maximum 15 nominations here as well. Another piece of good news came the same night. The film's director and cast won the Vanguard Award at the festival. But what's in this acclaimed film?

The film was made in Spanish by acclaimed French director Jacques Andier. It is the story of four established women in Mexico who want to be happy in their own way. Among them is a notorious drug lord who fakes his own death and seeks the help of a lawyer to start a new life. The story progresses with what happens next.

The film received widespread critical acclaim upon its release for its screenplay, acting, and production. The film has an average rating of 76 percent on Rotten Tomatoes.
