

BGB destroys drugs worth Tk 74 crore in Mirpur, Kushtia

Bablu Ranjan Biswas, Kushtia.. A huge amount of drugs has been destroyed in Mirpur, Kushtia under the initiative of 47 Border Guard Battalion (BGB). On this occasion, an anti-drug meeting was held at Shaheed Colonel Shamsul Arefin Hall on Monday morning. Kushtia Sector Commander Colonel Maruful Abedin was the chief guest at the program conducted by 47 BGB Assistant Director Zakirul Islam. 47 BGB Commander Lt. Colonel Mahbub Murshed Rahman delivered a welcome speech at the program. Senior Assistant Commissioner of Meherpur District Administrator's Office Nadir Hossain Shamim, Kushtia Assistant Superintendent of Police (Mirpur-Bheramara) Circle Jahangir Alam and Mirpur Upazila Assistant Commissioner (Land) Kazi Md. Meshkatul Islam spoke. At this time, Kushtia Sector General Staff Officer Major Shafiqul Islam, 58 BGB General Staff Officer Major Molla Obaidur Rahman, Kushtia Sector Assistant Director Shamim Parvez and others were present.

Later, the guests were presented with 9,368 bottles of foreign liquor, 11,000 bottles of phensidyl, 127 kg of marijuana, 124,577 packets of leaf bidi, 7,247 packets of yaba, 22 kg of cocaine, 1,350 packets of Viagra, 8 kg 600 grams of heroin, 56 bottles of LSD and 1,87,677 packets of various tablets seized by 47 BGB at different times.
