

On that demand, students of Narsingdi Polytechnic Academy Dhaka-Sylhet highway blockade

Haladhar Das, Narsingdi :: Students of the Technical Student Movement of Bangladesh are protesting to collect six points. In this connection, students from all the government-private polytechnic institutes of Narsingdi blocked the Dhaka-Sylhet highway in the Sahipratap area on Wednesday (April 16) from 10:00 am.

It caused traffic jams across the area of [] about five kilometers on both sides of the Dhaka-Sylhet highway. Later, the students lifted the siege at around 12:30 pm on the basis of the assurance of the Deputy Commissioner and Superintendent of Police.

We have been demanding six points for a long time.

The claims are:

The High Court canceled the verdict of illegal promotion of the Craft Instructor for Junior Instructor.

Craft Instructor Designation will be permanently dismissed by those concerned in the case.

The appointment of the appointed instructors appointed in the night in 2021 will have to be completely canceled.

The controversial recruitment must be corrected immediately.

Diploma in-engineering courses should ensure a four-year quality curriculum in the developed world, including cancellation of admission opportunities at any age.

Academic activities must be introduced from the subsequent regulations to full English.
