

BNP Holds Workers' Rally in Shibchar

Shibchar, Madaripur – A workers' rally organized by the Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) was held in Shibchar on Saturday, September 13, at 4:00 PM. The event, hosted by the BNP's Dwitiyo Khanda unit along with its front and affiliated organizations, drew hundreds of leaders and activists from different unions of Shibchar, creating a festive atmosphere.
