

Khaleda Zia's hand laid the foundation for modernization of education: Relief Minister Dulu

Lalmonirhat :: Disaster Management and Relief Minister Principal Asadul Habib Dulu MP said, "The foundation for the modernization and modernization of the country's education system was laid by the late Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia. The concerned expressed hope that the construction of the new building will further improve the educational environment of the school and that students will have the opportunity to study under modern facilities.

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
