

Youth rally to stop violence against women in Lalmonirhat

Lalmonirhat :: A youth rally was held in Lalmonirhat under the slogan 'End violence against women, give women the respect they deserve'.

The day-long rally was organized by the non-governmental organization Family Income Development Association (FIDA) at the District Council Auditorium on Monday.
